Dear Parents and Carers,

Once again, we find ourselves waiting for information regarding the possible return to school. Below outlines the information announced by the First Minister this morning. Schools at this point have no further information. Of course, once any further detail is received, we will communicate how this will affect you as a family in a timely manner.

Welsh Government Announcement (as of 8.30am)

The Welsh Government said it would work with "schools and education partners on a phased and flexible return to school" after 22 February, providing the public health situation continued to improve. The First Minister commented that there was a "strong case" for having the very youngest children back in school as "they're not able to learn online and remotely"

Childcare provision and COVID-19

Transmission rates are still high in our community.

If there is a case of COVID-19 in the childcare hub, children and staff attending will be asked to self-isolate and the childcare hub bubble will close until further notice. If anyone has symptoms in your family, it is vitally important that you inform the school and that you do not send your child into the setting. The school requires confirmed notification of both a positive and negative test. If you have any doubts about whether your child is well enough to attend, they should remain at home.

Childcare provision during half term

Newport City Council have confirmed this week that hub provision in schools will not be available over the half-term.

Information/ Key Questions from Welsh Government regarding Hub provision

Will schools be open to any learners? Schools and colleges will remain open for children of critical workers and vulnerable learners, as well as for learners who need to complete essential exams or assessments.

How do local authorities identify who is a critical worker? Local authorities must have regard to the list when deciding who is a critical worker. In deciding who is a critical worker,

local authorities will also want to reflect on types of employment and associated impacts in their area.

The law only requires one parent to be a critical worker for the obligation to make arrangements to apply.

Being included on the key worker list does not mean children of all workers in these categories can or will be able to continue to send their children to school. Many parents working in these sectors may be able to ensure their child is kept at home. Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be. However, if a parents/carers work is critical to the COVID-19 response or is in a key sector such as health and social care and the child/children cannot be kept safely at home, then priority should be given for continued education provision.
